It's a big change for children to start in the SFO. The familiar and safe kindergarten is replaced by a new environment and there are many new faces, routines and norms that require getting used to.

Self-reliance among the children eases the transition from kindergarten to SFO and it frees the SFO staff's time to help children with other activities. Therefore, it is important that children know basic self-help skills, such as:

- Taking their jacket on/off when they go out/in.
- Finding their own lunchboxes.
- Keeping track of where their clothes are.
- Using the toilet independently.

It will be a great help for your child if:

- Their clothes are labelled with their names.
- There is a change of clothes lying in their wardrobe, especially underwear, socks and pants. There is additional clothing for rainy and cold weather, such as rainwear, wellies and a fleece sweater.
